

We're thrilled that you chose to go on safari with us, and now is the moment when all of the planning pays off and your safari dreams begin to come true. However you approach Nyungwe National Park, the transition from a rural Rwandan landscape of terraced hills and tea plantations to the atmospheric depths of East Africa's largest montane rainforest is sensational. No less remarkable is Nyungwe's biodiversity, which includes 1,050 plant, 85 mammal, 310 bird, 38 reptile, 32 amphibian and 120 butterfly species. Primate viewing is exceptional, with 13 species recorded, most notably chimpanzee. Nyungwe is also Rwanda's most important destination for dedicated birdwatchers, thanks to the presence of 27 Albertine Rift native birds, but even casual visitors will do a double take when they see a great blue turaco flap past like a brightly colored turkey.

Volcanoes National Park

A magical highland landscape of clumped bamboo towers, tangled jungles and soaring volcanic peaks, Volcanoes National Park protects a chain of imposing mountains that rise to a maximum elevation of 4,507m. More than half the world's mountain gorillas live in these forested mountains, and tracking these gigantic but peaceable apes in the wild is one of the most thrilling experiences on offer in Africa. Other wildlife present in Volcanoes National Park — which can only be explored on guided foot excursions — includes golden monkey, elephant, buffalo and 180 different types of bird.
